



RINAT SHAHAM – Mezz-soprano

Internationally recognized as one of today's finest interpreters of Bizet's *Carmen*, Rinat Shaham first performed the role at the 2004 Glyndebourne Festival and most recently jumped into a run at Barcelona's Liceu. She has since portrayed **Carmen** in over 45 productions worldwide including in Vienna, Rome, Berlin, Munich, Hamburg, Stuttgart, Cologne, Baden Baden, Lisbon, Toronto, Vancouver, New York, Tel Aviv, Hong Kong, Sydney, Moscow and throughout the USA and Asia.

This season includes **Margret** in *Wozzeck* with the Symphonieorchester des Bayerischen Rundfunk and de Falla's *Three Cornered Hat* alongside the London Symphony Orchestra, both under the baton of Sir Simon Rattle, and a return to Bregenz for **Flora** in *La Traviata*.

Highlights next season see Rinat sing **Margret** in La Monnaie's production of *Wozzeck* and on the concert platform reunite with Sir Simon Rattle and the Berliner Philharmoniker for de Falla's *Three-Cornered Hat* as part of Musikfest Berlin.

24/25 highlights included a return to the Bayerische Staatsoper for **Eurycleé** *Pénélope*, de Falla's *Three Cornered Hat* with the Symphonieorchester des Bayerischen Rundfunks under Sir Simon Rattle and Mahler's *Das Lied von Erde* with the National Polish Radio Symphony Orchestra under Marin Alsop.

In 23/24 Rinat Shaham returned to the Bayerische Staatsoper for Purcell's *Dido and Aeneas* and as **Margret** in Berg's *Wozzeck* before travelling to Tokyo to perform in Beethoven's *9th Symphony* with Maestro Alan Gilbert and the Tokyo Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra. A further highlight of the 23/24 season included Rinat's return to the Barcelona Symphony Orchestra for Verdi's *Requiem* and Beethoven's *9th Symphony*.

22/23 saw Rinat's debut at Teatro Colon, Argentina singing **Judith** in Bartok's *Bluebeard's Castle*. This was followed by a return visit to the Wien Konzerthaus singing the Jeremiah Symphony under the baton of Marin Alsop with the ORF Vienna Radio Symphony Orchestra. Later that season, Rinat performed the Berio *Folk Songs* with the Rheinische Philharmonie before going to Opéra Royal de Wallonie - Liège to sing **Fenena** in *Nabucco*. Rinat closed the

season at the Berlin Konzerhaus singing Mozart's *Requiem* under the baton of Maestro Eschenbach.

In the 21/22 season, Rinat returned to the Liceu Opera Barcelona twice singing **Maddalena** *Rigoletto* and **Margret** *Wozzeck*. Other highlights included the *Jeremiah Symphony* with the Orchestre National de Lille, Berlioz *Nuit d'été* with the Bochumer Symphoniker and Steven Sloane and **Judith** *Bluebeard's Castle* with RSO Wien and Marin Alsop at the Wien Konzerthaus.

Past engagements have included performances of Ravel *Shéhérazade* with the St Louis Symphony Orchestra and Stéphane Denève; **Judith** in *Bluebeard's Castle* with Karina Canellakis and the Stavanger Symphony Orchestra and Robert Treviño and the Basque National Orchestra; her debut at the Bregenz Festival singing the roles of **Maddalena** and **Giovanna** in Verdi's *Rigoletto*; the title role of **Carmen** for Opera Australia (Sydney and Melbourne), Wielki Theater Warsaw, Florida Grand Opera and the Teatro dell'Opera di Roma; **Donna Elvira** in a new production of *Don Giovanni* directed by Krzysztof Warlikowski at La Monnaie, Brussels and at Angers Nantes Opera; **Preziosilla** in *La forza del destino* at English National Opera; a New Year's Eve Gala with Christian Thielemann, Lang Lang and the Staatskapelle Dresden, broadcast across Europe on ZDF TV; **Cherubino** in *Le nozze di Figaro* with the Israel Philharmonic; Berlioz *Les Nuits d'été* with Dan Ettinger and the Stuttgarter Philharmoniker and Beethoven's *9th Symphony* with Ludovic Morlot and the Seattle Symphony.

She has recorded excerpts from operas by Lully under William Christie for Erato as well as a solo CD of Gershwin and Purcell and another of Benedetto Marcello with The Viol Group "Fuoco e Cenere" on ATMA. She made her feature film debut as the Jazz Singer in the István Szábo film, *Taking Sides*, with Harvey Keitel. Her performance as **Carmen** from Opera Australia has also been released on DVD. Rinat's latest recording of Bartók's *Bluebeard's Castle* has won the Opera Award at the 2026 BBC Music Magazine Awards, recorded with the Netherlands Radio Philharmonic Orchestra and Karina Canellakis (Pentatone).
